

FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION PROCEDURES

PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT ENTIRELY.

ARMORY LOCATIONS

Per Indonesian Law, **ALL FIREARMS AND MAGAZINES** must be stored in a designated armory when not in use for the match. We have prepared 2 armory locations:

1. SWISSBEL ARMORY

Location: Swissbel-resort PecatuWho it's for: Participants staying at Swissbel-Resort

2. RANGE ARMORY

Location : Pecatu Shooting Range Area 1 Building

Who it's for : Participants staying in other match hotels and outside accommodation

**Equipment rentals will be picked up and returned here. Same firearm and ammunition armory procedures apply.

ALL ARMORIES DAILY OPERATIONAL HOURS:

05:00 - 07:00 11:00 - 13:00 16:00 - 19:00

ARMORY PICK UP AND DROP OFF PROCEDURES

To not overcrowd the armory, each region must assign 1-2 delegates to pick up and drop off firearms in bulk. Regions with more than 50 shooters may assign 1-2 delegates per shooting club or any other preferred grouping mechanism to pick up and drop off firearms.

Participants must adhere and agree to the following:

- 1. Participants **MAY NOT** pick up and drop off their firearms individually.
- 2. Participants **MAY NOT** store their entire bag of gear, ammo, and firearm in the armory. **THE ARMORY IS FOR FIREARMS AND MAGAZINES ONLY**. We do not store ammo and gear.
- 3. Participants must store ammunition responsibly in their accommodation.
- 4. Participants must return their firearms to their delegates to be stored in the armory at the end of each shooting day and/or when the event has ceased. Participants have a responsibility to

ensure their firearms are unloaded and with no ammunition in magazines when they are being stored.

5. As this is a high volume event, participants are responsible for labeling and bundling their items (if firearms are in a separated pouch or case as magazines for example).

Firearms and magazines can only be picked up in one of the following conditions:

- 1. For equipment check
- 2. During the participant's shooting day

AIRPORT TRANSFER PROCEDURE

FROM AIRPORT (ARRIVAL)

- 1. After disembarking from the airplane, clear immigration as usual.
- 2. At the baggage claim area, there will be individuals with Australasia passes who will assist you with firearms and ammunition customs clearance.
- 3. After firearms and ammunition are cleared by customs, Bali Police will escort the firearms to the armory you are assigned where they will be stored until needed.

TO AIRPORT (DEPARTURE)

- 1. Bali Police will transport the firearms from the armory to the airport 3 hours before your scheduled departure time (according to the flight information you provide to us via IPSC portal)
- 2. There will be individuals with Australasia passes who will assist you with firearms customs clearance until your firearms are checked in.
- 3. Go through immigration and board your flight.

GENTLE REMINDERS

- Know your airlines' policies. Generally you need to notify your airlines 5-10 days before departure that you are flying with firearms and ammunition.
- Double check that your name, passport number, and firearm details are 100% correct in the Indonesian entry-exit permit. Consult us with any issues or errors:
